AHCCCS Policy Review

Meet with Solari's Provider Support Services team to review AHCCCS policies.

Provider Enrollment Portal

Register as an AHCCCS provider via AHCCCS Provider Enrollment Portal (APEP) which can be found on the AHCCCS website.

02



Site Visits by Banner

All services will have either a site location that is used for services or documenting services. Each location will need to go through a site visit.

03



Onboard into HMIS and CommunityCares

You will be onboarded and trained on HMIS and CommunityCares, with coordination and support from Solari's Provider Support Services team.

04

1 ATTEND A PRESENTATION

Participate in the initial onboarding presentation with Solari's Provider Support Services team.



2 APPLY

Apply to be an H2O provider by completing the [H2O Provider Application](#).

Note: You must complete one application per site location and service type.



3 CONTACT FORM

If your application is approved, complete and return contact form. Contact form will be sent via email by a member of Solari's Provider Support Services team.

4 MEET WITH SOLARI

Connect with our Provider Support Services team to review AHCCCS policies and discuss the next steps of onboarding. Solari will reach out via email to schedule a virtual session.



5 REVIEW AND SIGN

If approved, Banner staff will send the contract to you via email for your review and signature.

APEP REGISTRATION

Register as an AHCCCS provider through the AHCCCS Provider Enrollment Portal (APEP) using Solari's guide. Solari Provider Support staff will connect you with AHCCCS POC's for support.



SITE VISITS/ CONTRACTING

Connect with Banner support for site visits and contracting. Solari's team will provide a warm handoff if needed. Each service location requires a site visit.
